Students, Parents, and Guardians:

Northrop students must make important choices by selecting the courses they will take the following school year. The *Course Description Handbook* will assist in familiarizing students and parents with the many educational opportunities at Northrop High School. This is located on the following websites:

The online course book will explain available courses, course sequences, graduation requirements, and athletic eligibility. This will assist parents and students as they establish educational goals. Northrop teachers and counselors are good sources for course selection recommendations. We encourage all students to challenge themselves with a rigorous schedule to better prepare for the future.

Current Northrop students may also check out a CD or course book from the media center or the guidance office for a short period of time. Please carefully read the information before completing the election sheet. ***All special education students*** will have an additional form completed by their teachers of record. The form should be turned in with the course election sheet no later than January 21st to your 1st period teachers. If you attend Anthis Career Center in the AM, please turn your forms into Guidance. Counselors will be calling classes down to the guidance office for scheduling beginning on January 25 during 1st period. Teachers will receive a calendar for scheduling. There is a time set aside for AM Anthis students and make-up days in the event of delays and cancellations.

The completed student election sheets determine the staffing needs and courses taught for the next school year. Student schedule changes will be permitted through Friday, June 4. Complete a course change request form from the guidance office before that date. It is very important that students and parents/guardians review the schedule that students will receive in May. **After Friday, June 4, no schedule changes will be made.**

The Academic Honors, Technical Honors and/or Core 40 are the available diplomas. Criteria for obtaining any of the diplomas can be found on the opening pages in the Course Description Book. We will make every attempt to notify you via the school newsletters, Edline and the school webpage if the State of IN makes changes.
